Dr. Allen Sinai is President and Chief Global Economist and Chief Executive Officer of Decision Economics Inc., and the founder of that organization, responsible for forecasting and analyses of the U.S. and international economies and financial markets for financial institutions, corporations, and government. Dr. Sinai is also Vice President and Global Chief Economist of Global Insight, Inc.

Dr. Sinai has served a wide range of financial institutions, corporations and government organizations in the U.S. and abroad during his career, tailoring information and advisory support to the bottom-line needs of each. He is well-known as a forecaster, educator and econometric modelbuilder, for his analyses and forecasts, especially of the financial markets, and is the developer of the Sinai-Boston large-scale macroeconometric model of the U.S. economy. He is a pioneer in econometric model building and the use of economic information systems for forecasting, analysis and monitoring of the economy and financial markets.

Dr. Sinai is Adjunct Professor of Economics and Finance in the Lemberg Program of International Economics and Finance at Brandeis University. He has also taught in the Sloan School of Management at MIT, at New York University, Boston University, and the University of Illinois.

He is a past President and Fellow of the Eastern Economic Association and a member of the Executive Committee - Western Economic Association; he serves on the Advisory Board of AYCO Asset Management Company, is a member of the Board of Directors of Boston Private Bank, and a Senior Advisor to Lehman Brothers, Inc.

He is a member of the Time Magazine Board of Economists. He published more than 40 articles on academic reviews authored remarks on economics and financial American and foreign markets for Decision Economics, Inc. clients.
